Canberra Cabernet Trophy Wins

Up until the most recent Canberra show, Australia's National and Senior Wine Show, Xanadu had won 7 consecutive Best Cabernet Sauvignon Trophies there - and 8 of the past 9.

In 2019 alone, the most recent full year of Capital City Wine Shows, Xanadu won 5 of the 7 Capital City Cabernet Sauvignon trophies - and then, from a winery that has about .02 of 1% of Australia's wines, also at the Canberra National Wine Show, they gained the trophies for Best Chardonnay, Best Single Vineyard White Wine & the White Wine of the Show.

Two years before, in 2017, the 2015 Reserve Chardonnay gained the Trophies at the Royal Brisbane Wine Show for Best Chardonnay, Best White Wine and Best Wine of the Show. It followed this up with the Trophies for Best Chardonnay, Best Dry and Best Wine of the Show at the Six Nation's taste off that year - against the greatest wines from Chile, the US, Canada, Australia, New Zealand and South Africa!

All of this may sound pretty impressive but to put the absolute dominance of this winery into context, apart from all its other trophy wins and accolades, it received those same 3 trophies for the 2010 Chardonnay in the 2012 Five Nation's competition. (Canadian wines were not included in that year).
